PREPACKAGED MOBILE FOOD FACILITY COMMISSARIES

A Commissary is required for all Mobile Food Facilities for 100% Prepackaged foods. The Mobile Food Facility (MFF) must be stored and serviced at the approved commissary on a daily basis. In addition, you must obtain a COMMISSARY AGREEMENT LETTER from an approved commissary.

The following facilities have been approved to function as commissaries in Riverside County. They contain the necessary equipment and space to accommodate the needs of Mobile Food Facilities as verified by regular inspection.

A restaurant or other retail food facility, with a current Environmental Health Permit, may also be permitted as a commissary on an individual basis. The facility must be inspected and evaluated to ensure they meet commissary requirements, meet minimum health standards, and maintain their Environmental Health Permit in good standing.

Out-of-county commissaries MAY be accepted under certain circumstances if verified to meet set requirements by this Department.

The following list may not be complete. Riverside County does not endorse any particular business. The commissary you select will need to meet the standards for your particular operation. Additionally, there may not be free space to accommodate your MFF in these commissaries, you will need to contact them to inquire.
