NOTICE OF A PUBLIC MEETING

FOR COACHELLA VALLEY COMPOST FACILITY PERMIT REVISION RECEIVED BY RIVERSIDE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH, LOCAL ENFORCEMENT AGENCY (LEA)

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Burrtec Waste Industries, INC. submitted an application to revise the Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) for Coachella Valley Compost Facility (SWIS 33-AA-0292), received by the Riverside County LEA which was reviewed and found to be Complete and Correct August 24, 2017. This application includes:

- Change the name from Coachella Valley Compost Facility to Coachella Valley Compost (CVC).
- Increase the size of the CVC leased area by 4.5 acres.
- Increase the supply of organic material from 250 tons per day (tpd) to 785 tpd.
- Addition of 200 tpd processing of Construction/Demolition and Inerts (CDI) material.
- Increase in liquid waste from 12,500 gallons per day (gpd) to 55,000 gpd.
- Addition of animal manure to the list of acceptable organic feedstock.
- Increase the total number of daily vehicles from 169 vehicles to 536 vehicles.
- Relocation and addition of scale/scale house, addition of employee break room.
