NOTICE OF A PUBLIC MEETING

FOR THE LAMB CANYON SANITARY LANDFILL PERMIT REVISION RECEIVED BY THE RIVERSIDE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH LOCAL ENFORCEMENT AGENCY

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Riverside County Department of Waste Resources submitted an application to revise the Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) for the Lamb Canyon Sanitary Landfill (SWIS 33-AA-0007) received by the Riverside County Department of Environmental Health Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) which was reviewed and found to be complete and correct on April 12, 2018. This application includes:

- An increase in the size of the permitted disturbance area from 580.5 acres to 703.4 acres
- Improvements to drainage and property access
- Relocation of the existing food waste composting facility
- Addition of new bird abatement procedures
