FOR THE PERRIS TRANSFER STATION/MATERIAL RECOVERY FACILITY PERMIT REVISION RECEIVED BY RIVERSIDE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH, AS THE LOCAL SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT ENFORCEMENT AGENCY (LEA)

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: CR&R, Inc. has submitted an application to revise the Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) to:

- Increases the daily tonnage from 1,800 tons per day to 3,000 tons per day.
- Increase permitted traffic volume from 779 vehicles per day to 1,016 vehicles/day
- Modify the public hours: Monday – Sunday, 5:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
- Increase floor storage capacity to 3,287 tpd
- Increases the total permitted acreage from 12.26 acres to 52.2 acres.
- Add a new C&D/greenwaste processing facility
- Add new parking lots
- Add new detention basins
