
This is in response to your letter to Steven Rhodes, dated 04/17/2008, attached, which is included in the addenda for Wednesday's (05/14/2008) Beaumont-Cherry Valley Water District meeting.

1. Mark Wildermuth is a civil engineer and not competent in groundwater, only surface water. His seal is attached to the final hardcopy of "Water Quality Impacts in the Cherry Valley Community of Interest."
2. "Water Quality Impacts in the Cherry Valley Community of Interest" is a hypothetical argument for the sewerage of Cherry Valley and not an unbiased study.
3. The supposed model in "Water Quality Impacts in the Cherry Valley Community of Interest" is merely a copy & paste of the surface water flow model from the USGS report, cited.
4. Allen Christensen, author of the cited USGS report, who does not have a problem with the nitrate levels, is quoted on interview in a recent news report in the San Bernardino Sun, attached.
5. Riverside County Health was informed of failures in "Water Quality Impacts in the Cherry Valley Community of Interest" by email in December, 2006, attached.
6. In January, 2007, STWMA was verbally and hardcopied violations of the US Code, CA Code, and RIC 389197 for failure to implement wellhead protection areas, attached. Many wells in Cherry Valley and Beaumont are at high risk for proximity to septic in the Vulnerability Ranking done by BCWWD for DHS Riverside. Mark Wildermuth was present and argued it was 100 feet per Riverside County. Dr Cindy Li of RWQCB has recently confirmed the default required distance is 900 feet.

The "Water Quality Impacts in the Cherry Valley Community of Interest" is worthless nonsense by gross error of omission and Riverside County and the City of Beaumont persist in breaking the law and endangering the health and well-being of their residents with failure to enforce implementation of wellhead protection areas..

The sewerage of Cherry Valley is merely a cover-up provided out-of-the-pockets' of Cherry Valley homeowners.
